You are required to bring evidence in paper format and hand this to your subject teacher during your first lesson.

<u>Level 3 National Diploma in Children's Play, Learning and Development (Early Years Educator)</u>

OVERVIEW OF SUBJECT

This course will provide you with the skills and competencies required to support children's learning and development from birth to 7 years 11 months. You will gain a full Level 3 qualification with a license to practice in a range of employment settings from nurseries and schools to holiday reps and hospitals. This course prepares you with a strong foundation of theoretical approaches as to how children learn most effectively in the early years. You will then have the opportunity to put this knowledge into practice during the 750 hours vocational experiences in real working environments.

ENTRY CRITERIA

To study the Diploma in CPLD you will need four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above from at least three different subjects. This **must** include English or Maths and preferably science.

You will also be required to complete a DBS check at the start of the course which is essential to allow you to undertake the compulsory placements of both courses
