Summer Bridging Work is an important part of your transition to Wilberforce Sixth Form College. This piece of work will count towards your effort grade. Please complete your summer bridging work in time for the start of term.

**You are required to bring evidence in paper format and hand this into your subject teacher during your first lesson.**

### Public Services

#### OVERVIEW OF SUBJECT

This course is for you if you have a genuine interest in furthering your knowledge of Public Services and you are considering a career path that enables you to use this knowledge. This course will prepare you for the world of work as well as giving you the opportunity to progress to further study. As part of your programme you will be studying subjects such as Citizenship to develop your academic skills to prepare you for the next level of study, practical fitness subjects where you train and take assessments for a range of public services and outward bound units where you take part in practical activities such as bouldering, go-karting and kayaking.

#### ENTRY CRITERIA

##### **Uniformed Protective Services: Military and Outdoor Skills Pathway – Level 3**

You must have a minimum of four GCSEs at grades 9-4 in three or more subjects. You should also have a grade 4 or higher in GCSE English Language.

##### **Uniformed Protective Services: Policing – Level 3**

You must have a minimum of four GCSEs at grades 9-4 in three or more subjects. You should also have a grade 4 or higher in GCSE English Language.

#### LITERACY AND SUBJECT TASK

For your chosen Uniformed Public Service (UPS) role write a beginners guide for a student in school looking to join. You must use researched information from the website of your chosen UPS e.g. <https://www.army.mod.uk/>.

You must cover training advice for

- fitness
- diet
- qualifications
- skills

Also think about what advice you would give them to get ready think references, discipline etc. Finally justify why they should come on a course at Wilberforce college to prepare them (what would they get from it and how would it help them to join).

You must ensure that all work in the beginners guide is your own words, if using any quotes from the public service you must provide a reference to the source you have used and explain them in your own words.
