Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Children's Play, Learning and Development

OVERVIEW OF SUBJECT

This course will provide you with a broad basis of study of the early years sector. It is equivalent to one A' Level and is designed to enable entry to Apprenticeship training or higher education. You will also have the opportunity to engage in 50 hours of working in a childcare setting.

- What is the role of the Early Years practitioner during the child's play?
- Consider indoor and outdoor play opportunities and health/safety.
