1. Freedom of information

The Freedom of Information Act gives the public a general right of access to information held by colleges (and other public authorities). The model publication scheme and definition document provided by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for Colleges of Further Education has been adopted by Wilberforce Sixth Form College. The College is obliged to respond in writing within 20 working days to specific requests from any individual. The College can be expected, in its response, to state whether it holds information of the type requested, and, if so, then, subject to certain exemptions (including Data Protection principles), communicate it to you.

The Model Publication Scheme provides a list of the information routinely published by colleges which the ICO expects them to make available unless:

- They do not hold the information
- The information is exempt under one of the FOI exemptions or Environmental Information Regulations (EIRs) exceptions, or its release is prohibited under another statute
- The information is archived, out of date or otherwise inaccessible; or, it would be impractical or resource-intensive to prepare the material for routine release.
