Media Studies

OVERVIEW OF SUBJECT

A-Level Media Studies is an engaging and dynamic course that explores the influential role of media in the world around us. This subject offers students an opportunity to critically analyse various forms of media, including film marketing, television, advertising, music videos, magazines, newspapers and digital platforms. It enables students to develop a deep understanding of how media shapes our perceptions, beliefs and values as well as its impact on social, cultural and political contexts. On the course we encourage students to develop their analytical, research and creative skills, not only to enhance the deconstruction of media messages through codes and conventions, but in preparation for developing their own media products.

ENTRY CRITERIA

A minimum GCSE average of 5.0 and grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
