NCFE CACHE Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner

OVERVIEW OF SUBJECT: This course provides you with the skills and qualifications to enter employment or potentially progress to a level 3 course. Assessment content includes topics such as Roles and Responsibilities of the EYP, Health and Safety of Babies and Children and Understanding how to support Children's Development. You will also participate in vocational training in a local Early Years Setting such as a school nursery, private day nursery or childminder.

ENTRY CRITERIA: A minimum of 3 GCSEs, including grade 3 or higher in English Language or Maths. A full DBS will also be needed for the placement element.

You are required to bring evidence in paper or electronic format and hand this into your subject teacher during your first lesson.
